The Jim and Betty Dye Scholarship Program has undergone some changes:

- ***The application is now completely online and will be available January 1st.***
- ***The SAT requirement is now 1200 and the ACT requirement is now 25.***
- ***Letters of Recommendation are no longer required.***

Minimum Requirement: **1200 SAT or 25 ACT (tests may be superscored)**
 3.25 GPA
 Attending IU, IUN, PU, PNW, IUPUI, BSU

Scholarship amounts: **From \$500 to \$3,750 per semester (\$4,000 to \$30,000 total)**

Application deadline: **March 1, 2018**
