Griffith Public Schools Parent/Legal Guardian:

This letter is to inform all parents/legal guardians of Griffith Public Schools' students that the Board of Trustees approved the 2018-19 Textbook Fees on May 17, 2018. The following fees reflect an accurate picture of what you are renting in regards to textbooks, technology, and consumables:

- Kindergarten - \$188.51
- 1st Grade - \$209.16
- 2nd Grade - \$209.06
- 3rd Grade - \$203.61
- 4th Grade - \$213.90
- 5th Grade - \$205.18
- 6th Grade - \$225.47
- 7th Grade - \$230.31
- 8th Grade - \$289.92
- 9th - 12th Grades - \$101.99 + Course Textbook and Consumable Fees

This is an increase from last year's textbook fees; however, in an effort to provide a better framework for 21st century skills and learning for our students, administration and Board of Trustees felt strongly that technology implementation needed to occur this next school year, adding an additional cost to the 2018-19 textbook fees.

In addition, you will find a breakout of each grade level's textbooks, consumables, and technology, which is attached to this letter, in an attempt to provide a better picture for parents on what is being rented. You can also locate the same information on Griffith Public Schools' website.

As you begin to register your child online on or after July 10th, parents/legal guardians will have a couple of options for payment in order to complete the registration process:

1. Pay in full through eFunds or
2. Payment plans throughout the school year through eFunds, but will need to be paid in full by April of 2019 for the 18/19 school year. Any balances remaining will be sent to collections in June of each year.
