

**NOTICE OF HEARINGS ON
PROPOSED SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS**

Notice is hereby given that the Board of School Trustees of Griffith Public Schools (the “Board” and the “School Corporation”, respectively) will hold separate public hearings in accordance with Indiana Code 20-26-7-37 on March 11, 2021, at 6:00 p.m., in the Large Group Instruction Classroom of the Griffith High School at 600 North Wiggs Street, Griffith, Indiana on its proposal to construct, and enter into an amendment to lease for the financing of the following three separate and distinct school improvement projects in the School Corporation, each of which projects cost in excess of \$1,000,000 but not in excess of the amount necessary for any of such projects to qualify as a “controlled project” as defined in Indiana Code 6-1.1-20-1.1:

Wadsworth Elementary Project – project includes improvements to Wadsworth Elementary School, including flooring replacement, painting of walls/corridors, boiler replacement, classroom unit improvements including installation of new ducts and diffusers, water pipe flushing and new HVAC temperature controls, and all related improvements.

Athletic Facilities Project – project includes athletic facility improvements to the High School/Junior High School, including replacement of the pool dehumidification unit, pool filter, pool valves and related pool improvements, locker room renovation with creation of home/visitor spaces, gymnasium wall improvements, and all related improvements.

Classroom/Boiler Project – project includes classroom and boiler improvements to the High School/Junior High School, including demolition of existing boilers and installation of new boilers, with related equipment, classroom unit improvements including installation of new ducts and diffusers, water pipe flushing and new HVAC temperature controls, and all related improvements.

At the hearing for each project, the Board will give explanations of the potential value of the project to the School Corporation and to the community, including its educational purposes and its estimated costs, tax impact and funding sources, and interested parties may present testimony and questions concerning the proposed project, including objections to and support for it.
